Subject: Appointment to the post of additional Chief Vigilance Officers (Addl. CVOs) in various Public Sector Banks

Madam/ Sir,

Applications are invited for the post of 05 (five) additional Chief Vigilance Officers (Addl. CVOs) on deputation basis in various Public Sector Banks as mentioned below:

2. The details are given in following paragraphs.

3. Tenure :

The deputation tenure of Addl. CVOs will be for 03 years or till age of superannuation or till further orders, whichever is earlier. The justification for continuation of the post of Addl. CVOs in PSBs (excluding State Bank of India) beyond 3 years' period will be reviewed by a committee consisting of two Joint Secretary level Officers from D/o Financial Services and the concerned CVO, in terms of letter no. 15/2/2019-Vig/RD dated 27.07.2020.

4. Pay Scale/Perquisites admissible to Addl. CVOs :

The officers selected as Additional CVOs in PSBs shall draw their existing pay of their parent organisation plus deputation allowance thereon equal to 10% of their basic pay. They will be entitled to perquisites admissible to next higher positions in the borrowing organisation.

5. Eligibility :

- a) Officers of the level of Deputy General Manager (DGM) of Public Sector Banks including that of State Bank of India (with 2 years' experience, preferably in vigilance/credit matters at DGM level) with a minimum of 03 years' residual service, shall be eligible to apply for the above post.
- b) The candidate should possess requisite experience in handling large value advances and should also have sufficient exposure in other verticals.

6. Selection Process :

Selection of the candidates for appointment to the post shall be made by the Government in consultation with CVC, on the basis of their service record and interaction with the Selection Committee.

7. Exercise of choice :

The candidates should specify the choice of their locations while applying for the post of those listed in table at para 1 above and indicate the order of preference. Candidate will be placed to the extent possible, on the basis of merit cum preference of the candidate. However, Government reserves the right to take the final decision in the matter.

8. Forwarding of applications :

Respective organisations are requested to forward the applications/ names of the willing officers along with their complete bio-data in the format enclosed, and attested copies of their Annual Performance Assessment Reports (APARs) for the last five years (complete in all respects) i.e. from 2017-18 to 2021-22, to this Department on or before **31.07.2023**. While forwarding the names of the willing officers, it may be ensured that:

- a) the services of the willing candidates can be spared for at least 03 years for taking up this assignment; and
- b) the applicant must have a minimum of 03 years of service remaining as on the last date of submission of applications (i.e. **31.07.2023**).
- c) the officer should not have any vigilance cases pending against them;
- d) the names of the officers who are under period of debarment need not be sent;
- e) officers, against whom any major or minor penalty was imposed in their career as a result of disciplinary proceeding, are not eligible for applying for the post of Addl. CVOs and thus, their applications may not be forwarded.

9. The names of candidates once forwarded for these posts will not be permitted to be withdrawn in any circumstances. Therefore, while forwarding the names for consideration, an undertaking may be obtained from the applicants to the effect that under no circumstances, they would withdraw their candidature once a decision is taken to nominate them for the post of Addl. CVO. While forwarding the application for these posts, a copy of this undertaking should be enclosed along with other requisite documents.

10. In the event of selection of the officer for one of these posts, the concerned officer shall be given three weeks' time to join new post/assignment of Addl. CVO, from the date of receipt of the order. If no response is received after three weeks, or if the officer fails to report for the assignment at designated place by given date, the process of his/her debarment for deputation in any organisation for a period of 05 years shall be initiated by his/her parent organisation after issuing a notice to that effect to the officer concerned. The formats for application have been prescribed in Annexure [Form 1, 2, 3].
11. The willing officers may send advance copy of their application in this regard to this Department for information by email at vigilance-dfs@nic.in. However, their candidature shall be considered only after receipt of the hard copies of the application through official channel.
