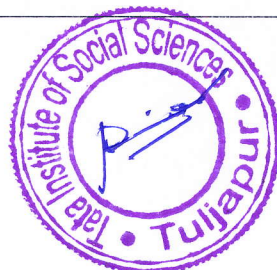

1. A two-credit paper requires 30 hours of teaching. A three-credit paper requires 45 hours of teaching.
2. A two-credit paper has to be completed within 15 working days; and a three-credit paper has to be completed by 23 working days.

**Essential Qualification:**

Good Academic record with at least 55% of the marks or an equivalent grade B in the 7 point scale with letter Grade O, A, B,C, D, E & F at the Master's degree level in the relevant subject from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from an accredited University. Please note that Relaxation of eligibility marks for candidates SC/ST categories will be applied as per the norms of the UGC.

Besides fulfilling the above qualification, candidates should have qualified for National Eligibility Test (NET) for Lectures conducted by UGC or Similar test accredited by the UGC wherever it is applicable, or have been awarded a Ph.D degree in accordance with the UGC Regulations.

The courses for which qualifying discipline specific degrees are not directly related, the candidates from related disciplines and/or with relevant field-experience can apply.


1. All the above appointments are to teach the specific course(s); the candidates will not have any right to claim for any regular appointment in the Institute.
